
# Medication -Assisted Treatment MAT

The Oasis Center MAT program combines medication to reduce cravings and withdrawal symptoms with behavioral therapy and family support to support patients in their recovery from opioids or alcohol.

# MAT Services

**Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) is a whole-person approach combining the use of FDA approved medications with counseling and behavioral therapy to treat addiction to opioids or alcohol.**

**MAT medications allow patients to build healthy behaviors and support systems to support long-term recovery.**

**Treatment options are available for people dependent on heroin, opioids, and alcohol.**



### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Oasis Center providers will assess if office-based medication treatment is right for you.
- You will need to be in moderate withdrawal to start MAT.
- You can start MAT at home with support from your provider.
- Oasis MAT includes use of Buprenorphine, Naltrexone, or Vivitrol.
- Oasis will work with you to create your own plan to support your recovery.



### MAT and Pregnancy

The Oasis Center provides **prenatal and postpartum care** for women with opioid use disorder, which can include the **safe** use of MAT.



### MAT Medications and Child Safety

Medications used in MAT must be **stored safely** and out of the reach of children. Children who take medication used in MAT may overdose. Talk to your Oasis Center provider about how to keep your medications safely away from children.
