This position is an essential member of the Oasis care team working primarily with pregnant women with substance use disorders facilitating support groups, providing integrated behavioral health services and follow up scheduled appointment in the clinic.

The ideal candidate will have strong documentation skills, knowledge of billing codes, be a strong team member, and have experience working with high-risk families and substance use.

This position is full-time, weekdays – *we are open to discussing differing schedules!*

Salary range starts at \$68,640/year

- Conduct problem-focused assessment and interventions for a range of emotional, behavioral, and physical health conditions
- Participate in collaborative treatment planning
- Conduct mental health assessments for children and adults

- Collaborate with the Oasis care team to develop family centered programming that promotes children's healthy development, positive parenting, and social connections
- Support development of parenting skills through modeling and coaching
- Document clinically relevant patient information
- Case management and collaboration with community partners to support family success
